



Tips on how to have the best time this October

General Farm Rules

- Please read and respect all signs that are posted, they are there for your safety.
- Please ONLY USE WHEELBARROWS TO CART PUMPKINS. We have a limited number so please return promptly so others can use them for their pumpkins.
- No alcohol on the premises
- No smoking or vaping except in the parking lot. (This is a family friendly event and fall is a very dry season.)
- Dogs must be on leash at all times except in the designated dog park. Always pick up after your dog. (read special note on pets, page 2)
- Do not run through the corn, please stay on designated paths.

How to Avoid Lines

- Buy pumpkins during the week and then come back on the weekends for activities and maize!
- Buy tickets online to avoid the ticket lines and then pick them up at the Will Call window.
- Come early on the weekends and early in the month. There are usually fewer people at these times.

- Please wait 15 minutes before getting into the Will Call line so that our system has time to update.
- You **CANNOT** buy extra tickets at the Will Call window, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Pets

It's important to think about what activities you would like to do before deciding to bring your dog. For example, the maize does not allow dogs therefore you will have to decide if you are ok switching your dog off within your group members or forfeit doing the maize. In addition, it's not the best place for dogs that are afraid of loud noises, lots of people, other dogs or other animals. Keep these things in mind when deciding to bring your dog, for some dogs it might be safer for them to sit this one out.

Random reminders

- Please be courteous to our staff and fellow visitors, so that everyone can enjoy the experience.
- Remember that this is a working farm and therefore there are some hazards we cannot prevent.
- If you come on a busy weekend there will be lines, so please be patient our staff does their best to keep up.
- Keep track of tokens, they can be easily lost.
